## Under 18 Curfew Policies

The safety and security of our youngest students is always a high priority at EF New York. The policies and procedures reviewed here have been created with this goal in mind.

We ask students to uphold these policies at all times. There are ***no exceptions!***



# Residence Hall Curfew

- All students under the age of 18 will reside in Lugari Hall in a “minor” designated room
- Each student must sign in to the residence hall nightly prior to the official curfew time
- All students who are not enrolled in a junior course and are **under the age of 18 years old** must abide by EF Curfew
- Curfew is set at **23:00 Sunday-Thursday** and **24:00 on Fridays and Saturdays**
- **JUNIOR** Curfew applies to all students **under 16** and is set @ **22:00 every night**



# Sign in and Bed Checks

- Students can sign in with an RA or Security at the entrance to Lugari Hall, from 19:30 – 23:00 (22:00 for Juniors)



- Students who are not signed in will be subject to bed checks. Bed checks are conducted nightly by our experienced RA team
- **Students who repeatedly violate the curfew** will be subject to disciplinary action, which will result in disciplinary fines, community service hours and letters to parents



# Waivers and EF Activities

- All students under the age of 18 are subject to the curfew and there are **no exceptions**, even if parental consent is provided
- Students attending supervised EF Activities and trips may return past curfew. An EF Staff member must escort the student to Lugari Hall when the activity or event concludes past curfew hour



# Overnight Policies

- Students who are under the age of 18 may leave the campus overnight with parental consent, provided there is a **responsible adult or other family member** who will be caring for the child
- Situations such as these will be examined on a case-by-case basis and the responsible party must come to campus to pick the student up
- Overnight Request Forms can be obtained through the Residence Life Office
- Requests must be submitted at least 3 days in advance
